### What is it?

The SAP project is focused on the VELS domain of Health and Physical Education at Years 4, 6, 8 and 10. The project aims to develop reliable and valid diagnostic assessment materials that are meaningful and interesting for students at these year levels in this domain.

### How can I contribute?

You will be invited to attend series of workshops to be held at the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) in March and May. Then we will work with you to pilot the assessment materials in your school in June. You will need to allow approximately 4 hours of class time to complete the assessments.

Funding for CRT cover will be provided to schools to release you to attend the workshops.

### What will I learn?

Participation in the project will provide professional development and learning that can then be included as part of the registration requirements for the Victorian Institute of Teachers.

It is also an excellent opportunity for your school to be involved in the development of cutting-edge assessment materials and to work collaboratively with the VCAA and DEECD
